RE: Installation of a New Post Light at the Parking Lot on Main Street

- *Remove and replace burnt GFCI receptacles and broken box in brick wall.
- *Hand dig from receptacles to parking meter.
- *Install 12' tall 3" round black steel light pole to be 4' in ground and 8' above ground.
- *Install PVC conduit and THWN wire in trench.
- *Wire pole and install selected fixture.
- *Install dusk to dawn photocell for light control.

Hi Jonathan,

The artificial light may help a little bit but probably not enough. It would all depend on how many lumens of light is reaching the solar panel. There really is nothing that compares to natural sunlight. Having an electrician extend the power from the proposed security light into the pay station would be the best option. The standard battery charger would require 115VAC so depending on the power supplied to the security light, the electrician may or may not have to install a transformer to obtain the 115VAC.

The kit required to convert the pay station from solar to AC is \$603.00 plus \$25.00 S&H. Labor to install one kit would be around \$230.00
