### ***Following are the communication items for this week:***

#### **March 13<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting**

In their March 13<sup>th</sup> meeting, City Council will review the Oakland County Sheriff's report for February, consider a resolution establishing the recipient of the 2022 CDBG funds, a motion to establish a Parking Advisory Committee, and a resolution to replace a vandalized "musical flower" in Depot Park. Starting with this meeting, we will be switching to Microsoft Teams for virtual participation in an effort to improve connection reliability. As always, the public is encouraged to attend City Council meetings – in person or virtually – to speak on topics of interest.

#### **No-Haz Program Participation**

Starting this spring, the City will be participating in Oakland County's No-Haz recycling program, which allows residents to inexpensively dispose of a number of different hazardous waste products at four annual clean-up days. The dates and locations for the 2023 event have been scheduled as follows:

3. **Saturday, July 22, 8 am – 2 pm**, Kensington Church, 4640 S. Lapeer Road, Orion Township
4. **Saturday, September 16, 8 am – 2 pm**, Oakland County Service Center Campus, 1200 N. Telegraph Road, Pontiac
