July 24th City Council Meeting

In Monday's City Council meeting, Council will consider a request to waive the park rental fees for a free concert in Depot Park sponsored by the Clarkston Independence District Library. The council will then consider appointments or reappointments to two seats on the Planning Commission and two seats on the Historic District Commission. Lastly, Council will hear a second quarter status update from the Historic District Commission and a Parking Activity & Income status report. The public is always welcome to participate in the Council meetings, either in person at City Hall or virtually using Microsoft Teams. EV Charging Station Active

The new EV Charging Station in the Washington & Main parking lot is now live and ready for use. Our contractor (State Electric) has completed the installation of the signage, the pavement markings, and the grass restoration. The two units in the Depot Road parking lot are close to being ready, just awaiting the installation of a transformer by DTE.

Third No Haz Collection Event on July 22nd

As a reminder, Oakland County will be holding the third of this summer's four No Haz (hazardous waste) collection events on Saturday, July 22nd. City residents are encouraged to take advantage of Clarkston's participation in the program, allowing you to dispose of hazardous materials you may have such as paint, pesticides, computers, batteries, motor oil, etc. for just \$15/carload, knowing that the items will be disposed of in a safe and environmentally responsible way. This third event will be held at Kensington Church at 4640 S. Lapeer Road in Orion Township, from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM.
